

**PRELIMINARY FALL 2008 ENROLLMENTS IN
ILLINOIS HIGHER EDUCATION**

Submitted for: Information.

Summary: This report summarizes preliminary fall-term 2008 headcount and full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollments at colleges and universities in Illinois. The report also summarizes 12-month headcount enrollments and enrollments in remedial/developmental courses during the 2006-2007 academic year.

Fall 2008 preliminary headcount enrollments at 214 degree-granting institutions total 862,504, while preliminary FTE enrollments total 627,118. Excluding enrollments at out-of-state institutions operating in Illinois, preliminary headcount enrollments total 854,660, an increase of 4.9 percent from fall 2007, and preliminary FTE enrollments total 621,472, an increase of 5.5 percent from fall 2007.

**PRELIMINARY FALL 2008 ENROLLMENTS IN
ILLINOIS HIGHER EDUCATION**

This report summarizes preliminary fall-term 2008 headcount and full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollments at colleges and universities in Illinois. It also includes 12-month unduplicated headcount enrollments and information on enrollments in remedial/developmental courses for academic year 2006-2007. Final fall-term headcount enrollments, aggregated by student characteristics such as gender, racial/ethnic group, class level, and declared major, are obtained during the winter and are published each spring in the *Data Book on Illinois Higher Education*. Fall-term enrollments provide a “snapshot” of Illinois higher education enrollments on the 10th day of the fall term. Twelve-month unduplicated headcount enrollments report the number of individuals who attend colleges and universities over the course of the full year.

Preliminary Fall 2008 Enrollments By Sector

Including enrollments at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois, fall 2008 preliminary headcount enrollments at 214 degree-granting institutions total 862,504 (see Table 8). When enrollments at out-of-state institutions operating in Illinois are excluded, preliminary headcount enrollments total 854,660, representing an increase of 4.9 percent from fall 2007. Headcount enrollments by sector for the last five fall terms are shown below in Table 1.

* Out-of-state institutions are excluded from Independent Institutions. Out-of-state institutions' preliminary headcount was 7,844. New this year, American InterContinental University Online, which is exclusively an online institution and was previously considered an out-of-state institution, is included as an Illinois institution. This change in status is responsible for an increase of 21,733 headcount enrollments in the independent institutions column of Table 1.

Public universities reported a preliminary headcount enrollment decrease of 873 (0.4 percent) between fall 2007 and 2008, while public community colleges reported a headcount increase of 6,465 (1.9 percent). Independent institutions (excluding out-of-state institutions operating in Illinois) reported a headcount increase of 34,490 (13.0 percent). Institutions in the independent sector are subdivided into two general categories in the attached detailed report of institutional enrollments (Table 8): not-for-profit and for-profit. Not-for-profit institutions reported a headcount enrollment increase of 7,986 (3.6 percent), while the proprietary institutions reported an increase of 26,504 (58.4 percent). The increase in enrollments among proprietary institutions was driven primarily by the change in status of American InterContinental University Online from an out-of state institution to an in-state institution. That change accounts for 21,733 out of 26,504 additional headcount enrollments at proprietary institutions.

Including enrollments at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois, fall 2008 full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollments total 627,118 (see Table 8). When enrollments at out-of-state institutions operating in Illinois are excluded, fall 2008 FTE enrollments total 621,472, an increase of 32,428 (5.5 percent) over fall 2007. The change in American InterContinental University Online's status to an in-state institution accounts for slightly over half (16,906) of the increase. Undergraduate fall FTE enrollment is calculated by dividing the number of undergraduate credit hours by 15; graduate fall FTE enrollment is calculated by dividing graduate credit hours by 12. FTE enrollments by sector for the last five fall terms are shown in Table 2.

* Out-of-state institutions are excluded from Independent Institutions. Out-of-state institutions preliminary FTE was 5,646. New this year, American InterContinental University Online is considered an in-state institution within the independent institutions column.

Public universities reported a preliminary FTE enrollment increase of 677 (0.4 percent), while community colleges reported an increase of 5,311 (2.7 percent). Independent institutions reported a net increase of 26,440 (12.3 percent) in FTE enrollments. Within the independent sector, not-for-profit institutions reported an increase of 9,073 (4.9 percent) in FTE enrollments, while proprietary institutions reported an increase of 17,367 (58.5 percent). American InterContinental University's change in status accounted for 16,906 of the 17,367 FTE change among proprietary institutions.

Preliminary Fall 2008 Enrollments By Level

Table 3 reports fall 2008 preliminary headcount enrollments by level, showing undergraduate headcount at 704,221 and graduate headcount at 150,439. Total undergraduate enrollment grew by 5.0 percent in fall 2008 while total graduate enrollment grew by 4.4 percent. Not included in Table 3 are undergraduate headcount enrollments at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois totaling 5,932 and graduate headcount enrollments totaling 1,912.

Table 4 presents fall 2008 preliminary FTE enrollments by level, showing undergraduate FTE enrollments at 513,031 and graduate FTE enrollments at 108,441. Total undergraduate FTE grew 5.6 percent in fall 2008, while total graduate FTE grew by 5.2 percent. Not included in Table 4 are undergraduate FTE enrollments totaling 4,248 and graduate FTE enrollments totaling 1,398 at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois.

Ratio of FTE Enrollment to Headcount

The ratio of FTE enrollment to headcount enrollment is a measure of the proportion of students that are enrolled full time. As illustrated in the table below, this ratio increased slightly in fall 2008 for all three sectors.

Total 12-Month Unduplicated Headcount

Twelve-month unduplicated headcount includes all students enrolled for credit from July 1 to June 30 of the following year (or from September 1 to August 31 of the following year). Total Illinois enrollment in the 2006-2007 academic year, the most recent for which information is available, was 1,288,548, a 4.4 percent increase over the number served in 2006. The change in American InterContinental University Online's status accounted for 3.1 percent of the growth (38,425 unduplicated headcount students). A breakdown by sector shows there were 234,744 students attending public universities; 368,840 at independent institutions; and 684,964 at community colleges.

Table 6 illustrates the number of students enrolled in Illinois colleges and universities (no enrollments at out-of-state institutions are included) over a 12-month period for academic years 2003 through 2007. Data are unduplicated; that is, they do not count the same person twice if he or she attended the same college and university in both the fall and spring terms. A person may be counted two or more times, however, if he or she attended more than one institution or campus during the same year.

Comparing twelve-month 2006-2007 enrollment to fall 2006 enrollment, an additional

482,145 individuals across all sectors enrolled during the spring 2007 or summer 2007 terms but not in the fall 2006 term. Students enrolled at community colleges accounted for 69.4 percent of this total incremental difference (334,456).

A significant number of Illinois community college students also enroll in non-credit courses. According to data collected by the Illinois Community College Board, in academic year 2006-2007, Illinois community colleges served 247,424 unduplicated, non-credit headcount students. When combined with credit-course enrollments, total community college system enrollment was 932,388 students in 2006-2007. Data on non-credit course enrollments are not available for public universities or independent institutions.

**Total Remedial/Developmental Students
Within 12-Month Unduplicated Headcount**

The following table summarizes unduplicated headcount of students enrolled in at least one remedial/developmental course during a 12-month period (academic year 2006-2007). Many students simultaneously enroll in college-level coursework and one or more remedial/developmental courses. Such students are included in these data. Detailed remedial/development course enrollment data are presented in Table 9.
