

**PRELIMINARY FALL 2011 ENROLLMENTS IN
ILLINOIS HIGHER EDUCATION**

Summary: This report summarizes preliminary fall-term 2011 headcount and full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollments at colleges and universities in Illinois. The report also summarizes 12-month headcount enrollments and enrollments in remedial/developmental courses during the 2009-2010 academic year.

Fall 2011 preliminary headcount enrollments at 214 degree-granting institutions total 895,730, while preliminary FTE enrollments total 660,274. Excluding enrollments at out-of-state institutions operating in Illinois, preliminary headcount enrollments total 881,341, a decrease of 2.8 percent from fall 2010, and preliminary FTE enrollments total 650,456, a decrease of 0.7 percent from fall 2010.

**PRELIMINARY FALL 2011 ENROLLMENTS IN
ILLINOIS HIGHER EDUCATION**

This report summarizes preliminary fall-term 2011 headcount and full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollments at colleges and universities in Illinois. It also includes 12-month unduplicated headcount enrollments and information on enrollments in remedial/developmental courses for academic year 2009-2010. Final fall-term headcount enrollments, aggregated by student characteristics such as gender, racial/ethnic group, class level, and declared major, are obtained during the winter and are published each spring in the *Data Book on Illinois Higher Education*. Fall-term enrollments provide a “snapshot” of Illinois higher education enrollments on the 10th day of the fall term. Twelve-month unduplicated headcount enrollments report the number of individuals who attend colleges and universities over the course of the full year.

Preliminary Fall 2011 Enrollments By Sector

Including enrollments at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois, fall 2011 preliminary headcount enrollments at 214 degree-granting institutions total 895,730 (see Table 8). When enrollments at out-of-state institutions operating in Illinois are excluded, preliminary headcount enrollments total 881,341, representing a decrease of 2.8 percent from fall 2010. Headcount enrollments by sector for the last five fall terms are shown below in Table 1.

* Out-of-state institutions are excluded from Independent Institutions. Out-of-state institutions preliminary headcount was 14,389.

Public universities reported a preliminary headcount enrollment decrease of 1,278 (0.6 percent) between fall 2010 and 2011, while public community colleges reported a headcount decrease of 7,838 (2.1 percent). Independent institutions (excluding out-of-state institutions operating in Illinois) reported a headcount decrease of 16,481 (5.1 percent). Institutions in the independent sector are subdivided into two general categories in the attached detailed report of institutional enrollments (Table 8): not-for-profit and for-profit. Not-for-profit institutions reported a headcount enrollment decrease of 3,807 (1.7 percent), while the proprietary institutions reported a decrease of 12,674 (13.8 percent).

Including enrollments at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois, fall 2011 full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollments total 660,274 (see Table 8). When enrollments at out-of-state institutions operating in Illinois are excluded, fall 2011 FTE enrollments total 650,456, a decrease of 4,808 (0.7 percent) compared to fall 2010. Undergraduate fall FTE enrollment is calculated by dividing the number of undergraduate credit hours by 15; graduate fall FTE enrollment is calculated by dividing graduate credit hours by 12. FTE enrollments by sector for the last five fall terms are shown in Table 2.

* Out-of-state institutions are excluded from Independent Institutions. Out-of-state institutions preliminary FTE was 9,818.

Public universities reported a preliminary FTE enrollment decrease of 231 (0.1 percent), while community colleges reported a decrease of 6,721 (3.0 percent). Independent institutions reported a net increase of 2,144 (0.9 percent) in FTE enrollments. Within the independent sector, not-for-profit institutions reported an increase of 745 (0.4 percent) in FTE enrollments, while proprietary institutions reported an increase of 1,399 (2.6 percent).

Preliminary Fall 2011 Enrollments By Level

Table 3 reports fall 2011 preliminary headcount enrollments by level, showing undergraduate headcount at 729,552 and graduate headcount at 151,789. Total undergraduate enrollment declined by 2.7 percent in fall 2011 while total graduate enrollment declined by 3.2 percent. Not included in Table 3 are undergraduate headcount enrollments at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois totaling 9,748 and graduate headcount enrollments totaling 4,641.

Table 4 presents fall 2011 preliminary FTE enrollments by level, showing undergraduate FTE enrollments at 537,058 and graduate FTE enrollments at 113,398. Total undergraduate FTE fell 1.5 percent in fall 2011, while total graduate FTE grew by 3.3 percent. Not included in Table 4 are undergraduate FTE enrollments totaling 7,258 and graduate FTE enrollments totaling 2,560 at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois.

Ratio of FTE Enrollment to Headcount

The ratio of FTE enrollment to headcount enrollment is a measure of the proportion of students that are enrolled full time. As illustrated in the table below, this ratio increased slightly in fall 2011.

Total 12-Month Unduplicated Headcount

Twelve-month unduplicated headcount includes all students enrolled for credit from July 1 to June 30 of the following year (or from September 1 to August 31 of the following year). Total Illinois enrollment in the 2009-2010 academic year, the most recent for which information is available, was 1,376,562, a 3.9 percent increase over the number served in 2009. A breakdown by sector shows there were 233,835 students attending public universities; 412,392 at independent institutions; and 730,335 at community colleges.

Table 6 illustrates the number of students enrolled in Illinois colleges and universities over a 12-month period for academic years 2006 through 2010. Data are unduplicated, they do not count the same person twice if he or she attended the same college and university in both the fall and spring terms. A person may be counted two or more times, however, if he or she attended more than one institution or campus during the same year.

Comparing twelve-month 2009-2010 enrollment to fall 2009 enrollment, an additional 477,309 individuals across all sectors enrolled during the spring 2010 or summer 2010 terms but not in the fall 2009 term. Students enrolled at community colleges accounted for 72.6 percent of this total incremental difference (346,375).

A significant number of Illinois community college students also enroll in non-credit courses. According to data collected by the Illinois Community College Board, in academic year 2009-2010, Illinois community colleges served 254,675 unduplicated, non-credit headcount students. When combined with credit-course enrollments, total community college system enrollment was 985,010 students in 2009-2010. Data on non-credit course enrollments are not available for public universities or independent institutions.

**Total Remedial/Developmental Students
Within 12-Month Unduplicated Headcount**

Table 7 summarizes unduplicated headcount of undergraduate students enrolled in at least one remedial/developmental course during a 12-month period (academic year 2009-2010). Many students simultaneously enroll in college-level coursework and one or more remedial/developmental courses and are included in this data. Detailed remedial/development course enrollment data are presented in Table 9.
